RULES AND REGULATIONS

The SCAHC is hosting another craft fair at the Bryam Township Fire Hall! The Byram Township Fire Hall is an indoor venue, handicapped accessible, and has heating/air conditioning. This is a working fire department; therefore, parking is not permitted in front of the building except to unload and load. DO NOT park in the “Fireman Only” space along the side of the building.

Doors open at 9AM for vendors to come and set up their tables, but they MUST be finished unloading by 10:30! Vehicles MUST be parked and out of the way by this time.

Vendors must submit the completed registration form and payment by Friday, April 19th.

Vendor spaces measure 10 ft by 5 ft, and your tables and/or display MUST NOT exceed this allotted space. There are a limited number of spaces available (and even fewer with access to electricity available for an additional \$5.00, and you MUST bring your own heavy duty extension cord), and everything will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Vendors are responsible for bringing their own tables and chairs unless previously agreed upon and rented by the SCAHC for an additional \$5.00.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Consignment shops or “yard sale” type vendors are not permitted. Only vendors selling hand made items will be accepted. This event is a fun way to bring business to local artists and crafters.
2. This is a family friendly event, so you MUST send detailed descriptions and pictures of what you are selling; we may use them in advertising for this event.
If your items are deemed “unfit” for the event, your registration form will be denied, and you will receive a full refund. On the day of the event, if what you are selling is inappropriate for a family environment, you will be asked to pack up and leave.
3. NO WEAPONS OF ANY KIND CAN BE SOLD AT THIS EVENT.
4. NOTHING is permitted on the walls and/or door frames! NO EXCEPTIONS! This includes, but not limited to, tape, thumb tacks, nails, double sticky tape, and any mounting products.
5. NO OPEN FLAMES PERMITTED.
6. You cannot start breaking down your display until AFTER 4PM when the Craft fair closes.

In the event you must cancel, you will get a full refund with advance notice of 5 days. If we do not reach 15 vendors, you will receive 100% of your money back.
