Gallery Policies

- **Please contact SCAHC with any questions.**
- Entries must be labeled on back with artist's name, title of artwork, medium & price.
- Artwork must be family friendly.
- Hanging work must be framed and securely **wired** ready for hanging — **no saw tooth hangers** accepted.
- Artists supply their own pedestals for **3-D** work.
- Work submitted must be ready to be exhibited in a safe and stable manor.
- All entries must be original to the artist
- SCAHC retains a 25% commission on all sales. Please consider this when determining your selling price.
- If not for sale mark "NFS" but include a declared value.
- The council collects sales tax on all orders.
- The SCA&HC has the right to decline any work that is deemed inappropriate for this event.
- Only designated personnel may hang or move artwork in the gallery.

Entry Fees:

- **SCAHC or AAUW member artists** - \$30 for 3 pieces or \$10 per piece
- **Non-Members of either organization** - \$55 for up to 3 pieces or \$20 per piece
- **Portfolios: 20** portfolio pieces wrapped in plastic (**Portfolio display rack no larger than 30" x 30" footprint provided by artist**) Free for **member artists** exhibiting 3 pieces of art in the current exhibit. (Portfolios must be removed at the end of the exhibit. Any portfolios including the stand and its contents not collected by the artists after four weeks from the pick up date become the property of the Council).
