### Crafts Guidelines

- Entries must be labeled with a unique item #
- All items must be listed on the registration form.
- Artwork must be family friendly.
- Work submitted must be ready to be exhibited in a safe and stable manor.
- The Council will arrange the display of all items.
- All entries must be the original work of the artist and for sale.
- SCAHC retains a 25% commission on all sales. Please consider this when determining your selling price.
- The council collects sales tax on all orders.
- The SCAHC has the right to decline, at any time, any work that is deemed inappropriate for this event.

### Important Dates

#### Drop-off:

Friday, November 18, 11 am to 4:30 pm  
and Saturday, November 19, 1 to 4 pm

#### Pick-up:

Friday, January 5, 2023 11 am to 4:30 pm  
and Saturday, January 6 from 1 pm to 4 pm

### Entry Fees & Size information:

- **SCAHC member artists / crafters** - \$30 for up to 8 large items or up to 12 small items
- \* Large is anything measuring 6” to 14” not to exceed 14” in any direction
- \* Small is anything measuring less than 6” but should not be less than 2’ x 2’
- \* Jewelry is the only exception to the size limit.

Craft items must be removed at the end of the exhibit. Any items not collected after four weeks from the pick up date become the property of the Council.
