Each category and level will be judged independently with the first place winners in each category qualifying for the New Jersey State Senior Citizens Art Show in September.

In 2016, six Sussex County artists had their work displayed at the state event and five received awards, two of them first-place category awards!

CATEGORIES

1. Acrylic Painting

2. **Craft** - one-of-a-kind original creations only, no craft kits or molds

3. **Digital/Computer Art** - artwork created using computer graphics software (does not include digital photographs)

4. **Drawing** - includes hand-drawn work in mediums including charcoal, colored pencil, graphite, pen+ink

5. **Mixed Media** – art that combines two or more media, no one of which clearly predominates; includes collage and assemblage

6. Oil Painting

7. **Pastel** - includes chalk and oil pastel

8. **Print** – includes all print forms including etching, linoleum block, lithograph, woodcut, monoprint, silkscreen, etc.

9. **Photography** - includes color, black & white or tinted photographs taken with a film-based or digital camera

10. **Sculpture** - work designed in 3-dimensions, carved or constructed in any medium, abstract or figurative

11. **Watercolor** - includes gouache

PROFESSIONAL/NON-PROFESSIONAL

PROFESSIONAL:

is an artist who meets 2 or more of these qualifications:

- a) sold artwork through commercial channels (including galleries, on-line galleries, craft shows, art shows, etc.);
- b) been exhibiting their work for 2 or more years in professional galleries and/or professional art exhibits;**
- c) had work selected in 2 or more Juried art or craft shows;**
- d) has received 2 or more awards for their artwork;**
- e) holds (or has held) professional membership in a guild or association.

NON-PROFESSIONAL:

is an artist who does not meet 2 or more of the above criteria.

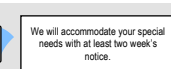
** **EXCEPTION:** Any artist who only enters their County Senior Art Show and who **NEVER** exhibits his or her artwork in any other show or venue does not have to identify themselves as a Professional.

DISPLAY GUIDELINES

All work must be *original* work by the exhibiting artist and completed in the last 3 years. Work must not have been shown in any past County Senior Art Show or and past NJ Senior Citizens Art Show. No reproductions of the artist's work (including giclée prints), copies of other artist's work or art done from kits can be accepted.

- Hanging artwork, photos or crafts, may be no more than 30" and no less than 10" in any dimension (including matting and framing).
- All 2D works must be ready for hanging: matted/ mounted, framed and wired, with proper label attached to the back of the work. Use screw eyes for hanging – no string, 'saw-tooth' hangers, table-top frames.
- Sculpture or 3-D crafts may not exceed 20" in any dimension (measurements must include any base for the sculpture). Work should not exceed 40 pounds in weight. Work must have the proper label attached to the bottom.
- Works on canvas must be wired for hanging but may be submitted without a frame if the edges/sides of the canvas are finished (not left white.) Canvases with painted edges or those bordered carefully with black duct tape are acceptable.
- Artwork should be protected, when appropriate, with Plexiglas, Mylar, glass or other clear material. Use of Plexiglas is strongly recommended instead of glass, and must be used if works are larger than 24" in any direction. The exception: chalk pastels, charcoal and chalk works should never be framed with Plexiglas, it can damage paintings using these media.
- Artwork valued at more than \$400 must have private insurance.
- If work is incorrectly categorized, it will be moved to the correct category.
